  - d.any additional information that you think might be helpful to the scholarship committee
- Attach 2 letters of recommendation. One letter must be from your pastor. Please provide translation if letters are not in the English language.
- Attach a copy of your official invoice from your educational institution with the full cost of your program/degree for the year.
